## AECC HOSTS TECHNICAL SEMINAR ON REAL-WORLD ZERO-IMPACT EMISSIONS FOR EURO 7 IN BRUSSELS

## Brussels – 26 September 2022

Tomorrow, on 27 September 2022, the Association for Emissions Control by Catalyst, AECC aisbl, and the International Platinum Group Metals Association, IPA, will hold a technical seminar on Euro 7 and an ultra-low emission driving event at Autoworld Brussels.

AECC and IPA have run rigorous technical programmes demonstrating how internal combustion engine vehicles achieve zero-impact pollutant emissions in real-world driving. At the event, attendees from European Member States, European Parliament, European Commission, industry, NGOs, academia, and others will discuss the latest emissions test data obtained over a wide range of driving conditions, question exhaust emission control experts on the technology, and will be able to understand the implications for the proposed Euro 7 emissions standards.

Three demonstrator vehicles will showcase a smart combination of catalyst- and filter-based technologies. Participants will be given an opportunity to be driven around Brussels' European quarter in one of the demonstrator cars whilst directly witnessing ultra-low tailpipe emissions in real time. A demonstrator truck will also be displayed.
